Dear Sirs,

We would like to draw your attention to the fact that starting from July 01, 2014 all perfume and cosmetic products circulated on the territory of the Customs Union of Russia, Belarus and Kazakhstan shall comply with Technical Regulation of the Customs Union on Safety of Perfume and Cosmetic Products (TR TC 009/2011) adopted by the Decision of the Customs Union Commission dd. September 23, 2011.

TR TC 009/2011 was adopted in 2012 and provides for a transitional period until July 01, 2014, within which period it is possible to produce and import products in compliance with the previously established requirements provided that the relevant conformity document is in place. Such conformity documents are considered valid until the expiration date of the same but no later than July 01, 2014. The only exception is about conformity documents issued prior to the date of the official publication of the Technical Regulation, which documents shall be valid until their expiration date.

TR TC 009/2011 has established the requirements for perfume and cosmetic products in the consumer packaging. It does not apply to products intended for ingestion, inhalation, injection or implantation into the human body, aids for tattoo applied with skin lesion, as well as products intended to diagnose and treat diseases.

TR TC 009/2011 has provided for a set of technical requirements for safety of the perfume and cosmetic products with regard to:

- · composition;
- physical and chemical parameters; microbiological parameters (there is a list of the products with respect to which the same are not defined);
- toxic content and toxicological data;
- clinical data;
- process of production;
- consumer packaging and labeling.

Labels of the perfume and cosmetic products shall contain all the information required to be labeled for the products of light industry, as well as an indication of cosmetics intended for children; nominal amount of product in the consumer packaging; color or tone for the makeup and coloring agents; mass fraction of fluoride in fluoride-containing products for oral hygiene; special precautions (if necessary), and storage conditions, if different from the ordinary ones.
