## *Decree of the President of the Russian Federation dated 19 October, 2022 No. 757*

### Dear Ladies and Gentlemen!

On 19 October, 2022 the **President of the Russian Federation** issued **Decree No. 757** "On the measures taken in the constituent entities of the Russian Federation in relation to the Decree of the President of the Russian Federation dated 19 October, 2022 No. 756".

The Decree introduces special legal regimes in the following territories:

- **Highest response level regime** – Lugansk People’s Republic, Donetsk People’s Republic, Zaporizhzhia Oblast, and Kherson Oblast;
- **Medium response level regime** – the Republic of Crimea, Krasnodar Krai, Belgorod Oblast, Bryansk Oblast, Voronezh Oblast, Kursk Oblast, Rostov Oblast, and the city of Sevastopol;
- **Increased alert regime** – constituent entities comprising Central and Southern Federal Districts (except for constituent entities where the medium response level is introduced);
- **Basic alert regime** – other constituent entities of the RF.

Each regime implies that the officials (executive bodies) of the constituent entities exercise **certain powers and measures**, provided for by the present Decree. Detailed description of such powers and measures is provided below.

The list of particular measures, timeline, details, and procedure for their implementation shall be stipulated by **resolutions of the supreme official of the RF constituent entity** with consideration to the present situation and risks emerging in the respective constituent entity territory. We will **keep you updated** on all changes being material for business, employers, and employees, as soon as the relevant acts appear.

## 1. Highest response level regime

Within this regime, the officials (executive bodies) of the constituent entities have powers:

- (1) provided by the Federal Constitutional Law dated 30 January 2002 «On martial law»;
- (2) to implement **mobilization measures** regarding the economy, the executive bodies of these constituent entities, and local self-government bodies;
- (3) to conduct **civil defense activities**, implement measures for protection of population and territories from nature and man-made emergencies;
- (4) to implement measures aimed at **meeting the demands** of the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation, other forces, military formations, bodies, and at fulfilling the needs of the public.

Also, **territorial defense** is organized in these constituent entities, and inter-agency coordinating bodies (territorial defense headquarters) are created.

## 2. Medium response level regime

Within this regime, the officials (executive bodies) of the constituent entities have powers:

- (1) to implement **mobilization measures** regarding the economy, the executive bodies of these constituent entities, and local self-government bodies;
- (2) to perform **particular territorial defense activities**;
- (3) to conduct **civil defense activities**, implement measures for protection of population and territories from nature and man-made emergencies;
- (4) to implement measures aimed at **meeting the demands** of the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation, other forces, military formations, bodies, and at fulfilling the needs of the public.

Supreme officials (executive bodies) of the constituent entities also implement the following measures:

- (1) strengthening the **public order enforcement** and ensuring **public security**, and protecting military and important state and special facilities;

- (2) introducing **special regime for facilities** ensuring operation of **transport, utilities, and communication, energy** facilities, and facilities posing **increased hazard** to human life or health, and to the environment;
- (3) temporary **resettlement of local residents** to safe areas, with obligatory provision of permanent or temporary housing to the resettled persons;
- (4) implementing and maintaining **special regime of entering and exiting** the territory, and imposing transportation restrictions within the territory;
- (5) **restricting traffic** and searching vehicles;
- (6) imposing **control over operation** of facilities ensuring operation of transport, utilities, and communication, operation of printing facilities, computing centers and automated systems, using them for defense purposes.

## 3. Increased alert regime

Within this regime, the supreme officials (executive bodies) of the constituent entities have powers:

- (1) to adopt resolutions on performing **particular territorial defense and civil defense activities**, and activities aimed at protection of population and territories from nature and man-made emergencies;
- (2) to implement measures aimed at **meeting the demands** of the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation, other forces, military formations, bodies, and at fulfilling the needs of the public.

Supreme officials (executive bodies) of the constituent entities also implement the following measures:

- (1) strengthening the **public order enforcement** and ensuring **public security**, and protecting military and important state and special facilities;
- (2) introducing **special regime for facilities** ensuring operation of **transport, utilities, and communication, energy** facilities, and facilities posing **increased hazard** to human life or health, and to the environment;
- (3) **restricting traffic** and searching vehicles;
- (4) imposing **control over operation** of facilities ensuring operation of transport, utilities, and

communication, operation of printing facilities, computing centers and automated systems, using them for defense purposes.

#### 4. Basic alert regime

Within this regime, the supreme officials (executive bodies) of the constituent entities have powers:

- (1) to adopt resolutions on performing activities aimed at **protection of population and territories** from nature and man-made emergencies;
- (2) to implement measures aimed at **meeting the demands** of the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation, other forces, military formations, bodies, and at fulfilling the needs of the public.

Supreme officials (executive bodies) of the constituent entities also implement the following measures:

- (1) strengthening the **public order** enforcement and ensuring **public security**, and protecting military and important state and special facilities;
- (2) introducing **special regime** for facilities ensuring operation of transport, utilities, and communication, energy facilities, and facilities posing increased hazard to human life or health, and to the environment.

#### 5. Creating operational headquarters

Supreme officials of the RF constituent entities create **operational headquarters** of constituent entities.

The operational HQ is **headed** by the supreme official of the RF.

Such HQ is **comprised of**:

- (1) representatives of the **RF Ministry of Defense**;
- (2) heads of the respective **territorial bodies** of the RF Ministry of Internal Affairs, RF Ministry of Civil Defense Affairs, Emergencies, and Liquidation of Consequences of Natural Disasters, RF Federal Security Service, RF Federal Service of the National Guard Troops;
- (3) representatives of the **public authorities** and organisations of the respective constituent entity.

#### 6. Mandatory nature of the resolutions

Resolutions of the supreme official of the RF constituent entity adopted within its competence are **mandatory for**:

- (1) **executive bodies** of the respective constituent entity;
- (2) **local self-government** bodies;
- (3) **territorial bodies** of the federal executive bodies acting in the respective constituent entity territory;
- (4) **other bodies**, including collegial ones;
- (5) **organisations** active in the respective constituent entity territory;
- (6) **citizens** registered at their place of residence (stay) and/or actually present in the territory of the respective constituent entity.
