Preparing the company for inspection of Rospotrebnadzor in Russia

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen!


Due to massive inspections and new sanitary requirements, ALRUD's experts have prepared this material for HR directors, compliance officers and heads of legal departments, on the preparation of the company, for inspection of the Federal Service for Surveillance on Consumer Rights Protection and Human Wellbeing (Rospotrebnadzor). It covers the main steps to be taken to prepare your company for an inspection, a list of violations to which Rospotrebnadzor gives special attention, and a list of possible consequences.


Please note that regional regulations may substantially differ, depending on the epidemiological situation in each region. *Please, additionally, monitor* the local requirements of the Russian region in which your company operates.

Verification of compliance with sanitary and epidemiological requirements




It is also necessary to follow the recommendations of Rospotrebnadzor, the wording of which contains the expressions "recommended" and "expedient to organize and implement", etc.

Availability of sufficient quantity of:

air disinfection devices (must correspond to the area of the company's premises)





antiseptic for hands

disinfectants (enough for at least 5 days, considering the area of the company's premises)



Please note that for some industries (for example, trade, public catering, construction), in addition to general regulations, special recommendations have been established.



Verification of compliance with sanitary and epidemiological requirements



The company has:

documents confirming the purchase of masks

certificate of registration of disinfectant


contact/non-contact thermometers

marking on cleaning equipment



Social distancing is observed

Employees wear and change masks when appropriate





Rospotrebnadzor may initiate an unscheduled inspection. Therefore, it is necessary to check in advance that the company complies with all requirements.



The company has adopted:

a log, or schedule, for fixing cleaning with disinfectants;

temperature measurement log and recording measurements for all employees

order to appoint a person responsible for preventive measures

instruction on the entry to the employer's territory



Main violations for coronavirus prevention



Failure to clean with disinfectant

In course of the inspection, the company may be required to provide a log, or schedule, for fixing the cleanings, as well as a log of the preparation of the disinfection solution.



Devices must cover the entire area of the premises, including the locations of visitors to the company (for example, in sales areas, common halls).

Lack of marking, or improper storage, of cleaning equipment




Insufficient supply of disinfectants

Antiseptics must be registered. In the course of the inspection, the company may be required to provide the relevant certificates.



Insufficient supply of masks



In course of the inspection, inspectors can record a violation if they see employees without personal protective equipment.



Lack of thermometers, daily temperature measurement log for all employees

Social distancing is not provided (at least 1 - 1.5 meters)



Person responsible for preventive measures was not appointed

The lack of an order in the company to appoint a person responsible for preventive measures, may be considered a violation.



During the inspection







Accompany inspectors and make sure that they do not go beyond the subject of the inspection



Provide all the required information

Inspectors have no right to demand information, documents, equipment, products, etc., which are not related to the subject of inspection.



Control the term of the inspection

An inspection should take no more than 20 business days. If the company conducts its activities in different regions, the total term cannot exceed 60 working days. If the verification period has expired, inspectors are not entitled to continue the inspection.

Consequences



Statement with the requirement to eliminate violations



After the expiration of the period, specified in the statement, Rospotrebnadzor has the right to order a repeated, unscheduled inspection.



Protocol on an administrative offense in relation to a company, an official (for example, General Director).



Fine for an official – from 50,000 to 150,000 Roubles;

Fine for the company – from 200,000 to 500,000 Roubles, or suspension of activities for up to 90 days.
